Examples of Entry Level Jobs in Customer Connections

- **Public Health and Prevention Specialist**
 - Consults with physicians, hospital staff, nurses, social workers, consumers, and local/regional health agencies on the follow-up of infants with abnormal screens.
 - Enters case information into databases and updates databases with additional information.
- **Customer Service Representative - Vital Statistics Section**
 - Interprets statutes, rules, regulations, policies, and procedures to approve routine and complex customer applications for records of Birth, Death, Marriage, and Divorce.
 - Reviews and certifies vital record applications for completeness of information and accuracy of requirements; examines the work of others for accuracy of information and compliance with Vital Statistics policies.
 - Examines and analyzes complex and non-routine confidential customer documentation, including legal documents, to ensure compliance with Texas Statutes and Vital Statistics rules and regulations.
- **Program Specialist - Immunizations**
 - Communicates with partners and stakeholders both verbally and in writing.
 - Plans, develops, and implements activities for internal quality assurance, compliance with program policies and procedures, and activity tracking systems.
